Overview: During the time period of March 15 to March 22, there were **90,794 mentions** of Medicare for all. This volume is high. Comparatively, net neutrality garnered 11,084 mentions during the same time period.

KEY FINDINGS

Beto O'Rourke, a 2020 Democratic presidential candidate, entered the conversation with his health care proposal that is not Medicare for all.

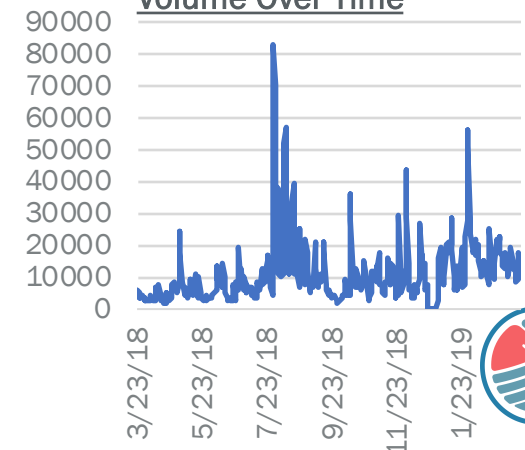
